DANNY ELLIOTT WINS 'PETER ALLEN VARIETY PERFORMER OF THE YEAR' MO AWARD, 2007

Danny Elliott has won the prestigious and coveted 'Peter Allen Variety Performer of the Year' award at the 31st Annual Australian Entertainment MO Awards which was held at the Bankstown Sports Club on 28 August 2007. Danny said that it was ironical that only this past year he has produced the 'Tenterfield to Rio' show which is a tribute to Peter Allen himself. Is Peter watching? Although a multi-award winner of both MO and ACE awards over the years, Danny was lost for words upon the announcement as he considers this his most prestigious Award yet. The accolades don't stop there.

Hugh Jackman managed to pip Danny at the post for the 'Australian Performer of the Year'. Danny made the final 7 in this category along with Priscilla – The Musical and Col Joye. Danny was certainly in good company. Nominations were also put forward for Danny in the 'Vocal Instrumental Performer of the Year'.

Danny's Company had an unprecedented 8 nominations in total for various MO awards this year, the most he has ever received. Danny's lovely wife Sharna was nominated for the first time for 'Female Vocal Performer of the Year'. Their duo 'SweetTalk' which is probably one of the most versatile duos around was nominated in the Two Man Performer Band section. Although only new, 'Kaleidoscope' showband has made an impact receiving its first nomination. Other shows produced by Danny himself were nominated in various sections. These were 'Stars of the Southern Cross', and tribute show 'The Elton Experience'.

The MO Awards were well attended this year with a host of celebrities present, including Don Lane, Barry Crocker and Frank Eifield.

Danny's first instrument is piano which he has been playing since the age of 4 years. Over the years Danny has mastered over 15 different instruments (and very well) which he showcases in his cabaret show. Danny has become a favourite club act for many patrons. Danny would be one of the few world class entertainers who are so diverse. He has performed with such greats as Shirley Bassey on her last Australian tour, Marina Prior, Tommy Tycho and his orchestra, the Ten Tenors, The Supremes and many others.

Performing on the QEII as a headliner act Danny was proclaimed by the entertainment Director, Brian Price to be 'the first act to receive a standing ovation since Neil Sedaka'.
